

Vernon Figure Skating Club - Fundraising Policy

Policy Statement:

The Vernon Figure Skating Club (VFSC) will provide fundraising opportunities for skaters/families to assist with club operating expenses, major purchases and other club expenses.

Guidelines:

- Participation in club fundraising is required
- VFSC has adopted a “fundraising block” system.
- Parents will be asked to provide post-dated cheques of \$50/block, one cheque per block.*
- Cheques will be returned after fundraising blocks are completed.
- Fundraising notices will specify complete details for order deadlines and order pick-up and delivery.
- Skaters and their families will be provided with multiple fundraising opportunities throughout the skating season.

Purposes:

- To provide opportunity for members to subsidize skating expenses
- To assist the club in keeping skating programs as affordable as possible
- To provide club opportunity to purchase specific equipment needed for skating programs

Club Responsibilities:

- Select and organize various fundraising events
- Coordinate product delivery and/or event with suppliers
- Notify all members of the opportunity via posters, notices, emails, etc.
- Provide order forms and/or instructions accordingly
- Provide detailed information regarding each fundraising event for the club website

*Exceptions:

- Due to the nature of team sports, all fundraising efforts coordinated independently by the Synchro team will be designated specifically for the Synchro team as a whole and used solely for Synchro team operating expenses.
- In the case of hardship, after discussion with the Board of Directors, a skater and family may be excluded from fundraising requirements and/or alternative arrangements made.
